CATARACT CANYON EXPRESS TRIP
1 DAY CATARACT CANYON

This 120-mile expedition takes you through the renowned Cataract Canyon in the heart of Canyonlands National Park. It offers some of the wildest, most exciting whitewater in the country during the months of May, June and early July, when the spring run-off fills the canyon's watercourse with raging torrents. From July to October, the river calms itself with lower water, but is by no means placid. Later summer offers pristine sandbars and warm water.

Our Cataract expeditions float you past the confluence of the Green and Colorado rivers through the challenging rapids of Cataract Canyon, in the midst of Canyonlands National Park.

Rapid class varies depending on water levels; trips begin and end in Moab, Utah.

Trips meet at our 378 North Main Street office and then depart from the Potash Ramp on the Colorado River and conclude at Hite Marina on Lake Powell. All trips meet at our office, **378 North Main Street**. There is a mandatory check-in the day prior to your trips' departure. You should consider bringing a hat or visor, camera and sunglasses.

- **Price:** \$425 Adult & Child.
(Minimum age 7 years – based on water levels)
- **Craft:** Motorized J-Rig. Jet boat service may be used to take you down river to the waiting J-Rig.
- **Additional Costs:** Park Service 4% user fee, return transportation option, and Guide Gratuity (optional)
