



## **CATARACT CANYON EXPRESS**

### **2 DAY CATARACT CANYON-Motorized**

This 120-mile expedition takes you through the renowned Cataract Canyon in Canyonlands National Park. It offers some of the wildest, most exciting whitewater in the country during the months of May, June and early July, when the spring run-off fills the canyon's watercourse with raging torrents. From July to October, the river calms itself with lower water, but is by no means placid. Later summer offers pristine sandbars and warm water.

Our Cataract expeditions float you past the confluence of the Green and Colorado rivers through the challenging rapids of Cataract Canyon in the midst of Canyonlands National Park.

Rapid class varies depending on water levels; trips begin and end in Moab, Utah.

**Day 1 & 2:** You'll depart from the Adrift office, **378 N. Main**, for a 20 min. (approx.) drive to the Potash boat ramp. You will then launch from the ramp into a geologic marvel. The Colorado Plateau will give you awesome views of towering cliffs, spirals and a great sense of adventure. Buffet style lunch, dinner and camp at the river's shore. The first day is smooth water as you'll float by Ancient Anasazi Indian ruins and enjoy the magic of the Colorado River and dramatic rock formations. Camp on the river's shoreline. After a hearty breakfast you'll embark for nearly 30 rapids on the Colorado River that include the Big Drops, Mile Long, Little Niagara, Satan's Gut, Capsize and Imperial just to name a few (*rapids may be run on day 1, in the afternoon, depending on weather conditions and water levels*). Once completing the rapids you'll motor to Hite Marina on Lake Powell and finish your journey with an included van ride back to Moab.

- **Price:** \$564 Adult & Child plus 4 % Park Service Fee  
(Minimum age 12 years – based on water levels)
  - **Craft:** Motorized J-Rig. Jet boat service may be used the morning of the first day based on water levels to take you down river to the awaiting rafts.
  - **Additional Costs:** Guide Gratuity (optional)
  - **Included:** Camping Gear (sleeping bag, tent). Van Ride back to Moab (approx. 3 hours)
